A flexible, palatable and highly nutritious diet, designed to be fed to cattle of all ages, including dairy cows, to ensure excellent health and performance. Nutritionally balanced to provide the required levels of energy and protein, together with essential minerals and vitamins for optimum health.

Feeding Guide

General feed guide: Recommended for feeding to lactating goats, dry female goats, billy goats and kids. As a guide, a dairy goat will eat up to 4kg of total dry matter depending on its size and stage of lactation.

Dry goat feeding: Dry goats should be fed at a level of 0.5kg per day with suitable roughage made freely available.

Lactating goats: Can be fed up to a maximum of 2.5kg per day at peak lactation, and again supplemented with good quality roughage. For very high yielding animals BOCM PAULS Goat 21 Pellets with added magnesium is recommended.

Kid feeding: Should be offered to kids on an 'ad lib' basis with access to good quality roughage.

Additional Information

The ratio between Farmgate Coarse Goat and roughage should be 60:40, respectively, when goats are in early lactation. In mid lactation the respective ratio should be 45:55, and in late lactation 25:75.

A fresh supply of clean water should always be available. Enough drinking trough space should be allowed so that at least 10% of the herd is able to drink at once.

Feeding little and often is suggested with high feeding levels in early lactation. This will ensure that your goats have healthy appetites.

Goats in late pregnancy should be 'fit but not fat' to help ensure ease at kidding.

Store Farmgate feed in a cool dry place.

Dairy Goat Mix

A mix of cereals and pulses optimised for the high yielding dairy goat. Should be introduced about 2 weeks before kidding, starting with just a few handfuls, and gradually building up to about 0.5kg a day by the time the kids are born. After the birth of kids, the feed should be slowly increased to about 2kg a day. A milking goat producing about 4.5 litres of milk a day will need about 2kg of mix a day. Depending on the individual goat, you may need to increase the amount further if she is producing more milk, by about 1kg for every extra gallon of milk, though the goat may not want to eat this much.

Herbal Goat Mix

A herbal mix with alfalfa, which has been found to be particularly suited to Pygmy goats, shy feeders and goats under stress.

FEEDING GUIDE FOR PYGMY GOATS

Pygmy goats thrive on routine so should be fed at the same time each day. It is advisable to feed them twice per day, splitting the mix evenly between each meal. The rest of their daily diet should be made up of good quality hay, which can be made available at all times for them to help themselves. Make sure that clean, fresh water is also available at all times.

Remember that THE AMOUNTS IN THE TABLE BELOW ARE GUIDES ONLY. Each pet is an individual and needs to be treated as such.
